Dear Customer,

Occasionally we receive questions from customers regarding the possibility of installing switches, circuit breakers or placards into positions not stated in the FAA Approved Installation Instructions.

Due to the many variations of cockpit layout and customization it is not possible to comply with this request.

FDC Policy is that we have No Technical Objection to the relocation of these cockpit components provided that the following is adhered and agreed to.

1. The components are located in plain view and easy reach of the pilot where required for safe operation.
2. The Manufacturers Standard Practices and FAA Standard Practices as per AC43-13 are adhered to.
3. The Approval of the Local Airworthiness Authority, where required, is obtained by the end user.
4. The customer is responsible to ensure all steps above are complied with.
